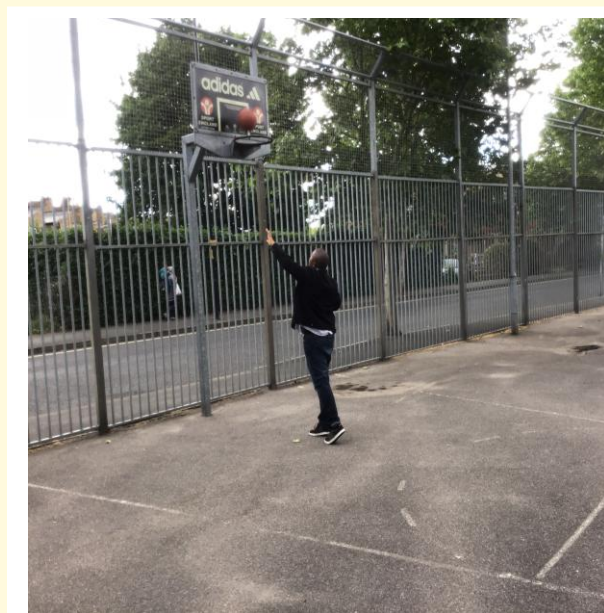

Educational

The school went to Stepney Way City Farm this week. Learners were excited by the new environment; they stroked the farm animals and fed them. It is increasingly believed that interactions with animals are beneficial for autistic learners. Learners would have experienced fewer meltdowns as well as reduced stress and anxiety levels. Stroking animals can also help improve their communication and confidence. It was a lovely experience for the learners and we hope to go back soon.

WEEKLY STRATEGIES

A common challenge for children and adults with autism is their ability to communicate. Many parents and therapist will tell you that "Pictures Cards" are one of the best tools to aid in communication with individuals with autism, whether the individual is verbal or non-verbal. Many people with autism are visual learners, while some respond to spoken words and others to written words.

For those with no spoken language, you can use pictures cards or visual symbols (pending on their cognitive levels) to figure out what they want and help them to let you know their thoughts or desires. Create a visual table of things they enjoy, their favorite activities or upcoming events. Affix Velcro to the back of the picture so that only those selected are an option for the individual to place on the board. This will better facilitate choice making and minimize anxiety or frustration- **Stages**



The Bridge SEN School now runs an **ASD Activity Club** on Saturdays, 10am to 4pm, and Mondays 5pm to 8pm. There are lots of activities available for young learners within the ages of 16 to 25 years. 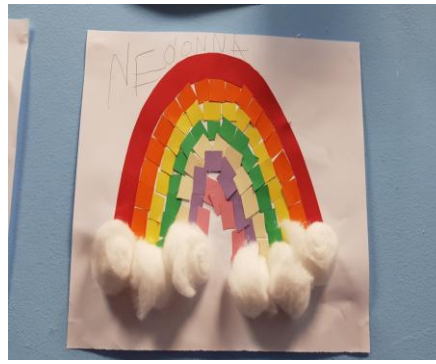
